Yesterday was the last day of SATS, which traditionally in our school means a "snow" fight, using the practice materials from the previous weeks! Well done to the Year 6 children and staff for such a successful week.

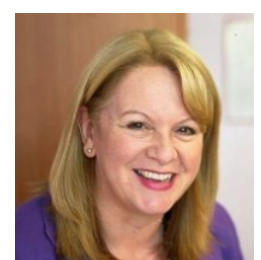

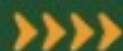
