If you would like to participate, please bring the items into school and place them on our Food Bank table which is located near to the main entrance.



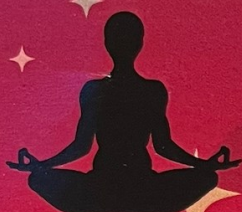
